

STAY TUNED - COMING TO MCP.com IN A BIG WAY!

In addition to the many upgrades and expansions forthcoming, in the short term we will also see a major change for documenting statistical analysis of all the goings-on with visitation and use of our website! The installation of a corporate-level version of **Google GA4 Analytics and Tag Manager** will serve as an overarching collector of site data – set-up is anticipated soon! This should provide the statistical use data that we have all been hoping to have generated by the site for specific counties, facilities, overall site use, etc. (3) (3)

FALL COLORS ACTIVITY AWAITS YOUR PARK ASSIGNMENT!

A reminder that the new "FALL COLORS" activity that was installed on MCP.com in early August is still looking to add YOUR PARK(S) to our statewide listing & map! Kudos to the first 22 CCBs that have tagged this Activity to at least one of their parks – which means there's a potential for another 77 counties to jump on this FREE marketing opportunity! (a) We're awaiting at least a 50% participation by CCBs prior to partnering with our friends with the lowa Tourism Office! (NOTE: Once the activity is added to your park, it remains in the "Sort" for that Activity until it may be removed)







Q.R. CODING YOUR EVENTS & OTHER URLs - VIA MCP.com (3)

If you are one of the 230+ folks attending the ICCS Fall Conference in Council Bluffs next week (Sept. 19-21) – you will have the "Conference QR Code" available for ALL the essential conference information! Various Agendas, Conference Programs, Business Meeting info. & IWLA Habitat Awards data – all quickly accessible via the code destination constructed in MCP!

We have successfully been utilizing this option for the past couple of years at Winterfest, the ICCS Fall Conference and at ISAC meetings. Need one for something you are hosting or doing? Especially in the education arena? AND – they don't have to be accessible to the public!



For EVENT codes, simply construct a "non-visible' Event in your ADMIN, and when completed – use the embedded **QR Code** generator within that particular Event. You will note in the example to the right that there are **FIVE links** within this code that users can click on – all going to various PDFs of information for the event. Additionally, we recently installed a general **Q.R. Code Generator within your County Admin** options (shown here on the left) that you can drop ANY URL address into and create a downloadable QR Code for your use! Our all-new MyCountyParks.com website in 2024 is specifically being designed for marketing, promotion and seamless ease of use by customers and Admins alike – QR code connections should also be an integral part of YOUR CCB's future!
