



Appreciation to DCCB Director Josh Batterson for hosting the June District 5 meeting in their shelter at the McGowen Wildlife Area east of Bloomfield, IA. The District 5 Business Meeting was followed by a field trip to visit a trail project that is connecting the city of Bloomfield to the west edge of the

McGowen Wildlife Area. After a short hike that was uphill both ways, the group adjourned to a local restaurant for a networking luncheon. The Business Meeting included a discussion about District Bylaws that were completely out of date, and perhaps last reviewed in the early '90s. The interim consensus of the CCB representatives assembled was to suspend the Bylaws pending further review to ascertain need, etc. Dist. 5 is also considering housing their District funds in an account with the ICCS banking structure.

#### DISTRICT MEETING REGISTRATIONS & MEAL COUNTS

At more than one District meeting recently, the hosting CCB (and/or the District bank account) has gotten saddled with the cost of last-minute cancellations – primarily the morning refreshments and guaranteed numbers for catered meals or restaurant reservations. In one case, there were 10 last-minute cancellations wherein the people that actually attended chipped in money so that the county did not get stuck with a \$100+ tab. Short of billing the CCBs for no-shows, what to do?

Some Districts have gone to restaurant-only dining - with reservations for a range of numbers (ie: 35-40) - usually more costly, involves a drive, and perhaps less conducive to networking/luncheon presentations, etc. We DO HAVE an Online



Registration System that could be used for District Meetings – whether you want to have participants pay in advance or not. If they pay in advance, however – at least the \$\$ are collected. (If any District is interested in using this system, just be in touch and we can visit about the possibilities - IACCB@mycountyparks.org ) I believe everyone understands when there are emergencies that generate cancellations, but perhaps more consideration needs to be shown to host CCBs that commit to hosting and providing breaks, supplies and luncheon arrangements in anticipation of "X" attendees, and then end up with "Y". Simply honoring your RSVP's would be a great consideration. All CCBs will eventually will be hosting a District Meeting, and appreciate the same courtesy extended in return. We have been holding District Meetings for 60 years.....nothing really new here....let me know where ICCS can assist!!
