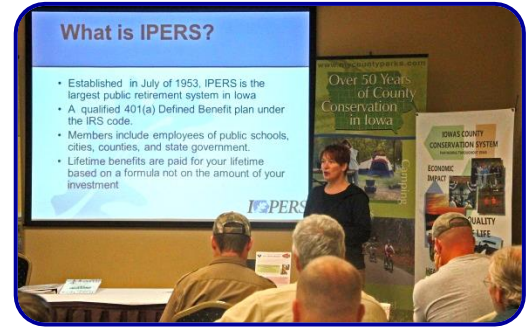




NEW COUNTY CONSERVATION EMPLOYEE SCHOOL - 2017
