Overview of process and expectations:

- Upon receipt of your completed application, the Chief Firearms Instructor for the CCPOA will share your application with the executive Committee and the Firearms Instructor Team for review and action.
- Once accepted as a candidate, it is your responsibility to register with ILEA for the Firearms Instructor School. It is your responsibility to obtain all of your gear and ammunition required for attendance.
- Upon successful completion of the required goals of the course, you can apply for 50% reimbursement of the ILEA tuition.
- Upon completion, email a copy of your ILEA Firearms certification to the Chief Instructor.
- You are required to recertify at your counties expense every three (3) years.
- You will be expected to serve as a CCPOA Firearms Instructor a minimum of six (6) years from date of initial completion.
