

CCPOA FIREARM RULES

General Firearm Rules

- Treat all firearms as though they were loaded.
- Point the muzzle in a safe direction at all times.
- Keep finger outside the trigger guard until you are on target and have decided to fire.
- Be sure of your target and what is beyond.

CCPOA Range Safety Rules

1. Ear and eye protection required at all times when firing is being conducted on the range, including observers.
2. Immediately upon picking up a firearm, lock the slide to the rear, visually and physically check to see that it is unloaded.
3. Check a second time.
4. Never give a firearm to, or take a firearm from, anyone unless the slide is locked to the rear at all times.
5. Load only after position is taken at the firing line and the command to load is given.
6. Unload, reload, de-cock or unlock as instructed.
7. Keep the firearm pointed down-range at all times.
8. Never draw a handgun from the holster on the range unless instructed.
9. Never draw/re-holster with your finger in the trigger guard or on the trigger.
10. Never leave your firing point unless instructed to do so.
11. Never go forward of the firing line unless instructed.
12. Never bend over to retrieve dropped articles on the firing line until instructed to do so by an instructor.
13. No talking on the firing line; except by, or with an instructor.
14. Pay strict attention to the instructors.
15. Never permit the muzzle of a firearm to touch the ground.
16. Conduct a proper safety check of the weapon before and after a training session.
17. Never dry fire on the range unless instructed to do so.
18. All safety precautions must be adhered to and will be enforced.
19. No chewing or smoking on the firing line-
20. Do not step on railroad ties or target stands.
21. **REMEMBER:** Everyone has the responsibility for range safety.
