Browser Hygiene: The Importance of Clearing Cache and Cookies

So, what are cookies?
Simply put, "cookies" are actually small packets of data sent to your browser from websites you visit, containing information about your activity on the page, which your browser then saves as a small text file. That information can include your username and password, site preferences, or what you might've left in your Amazon shopping cart -- the browser saves that stuff so you don't have to re-enter it every time, which is nice.

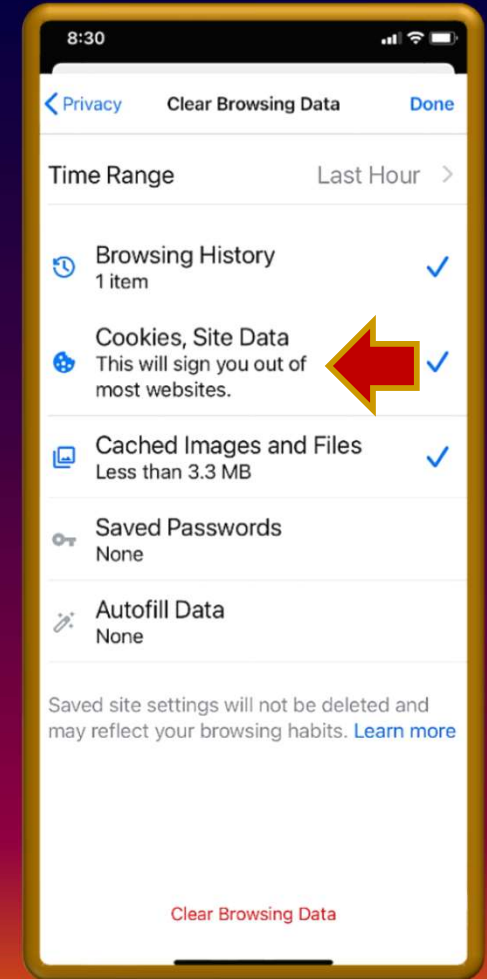
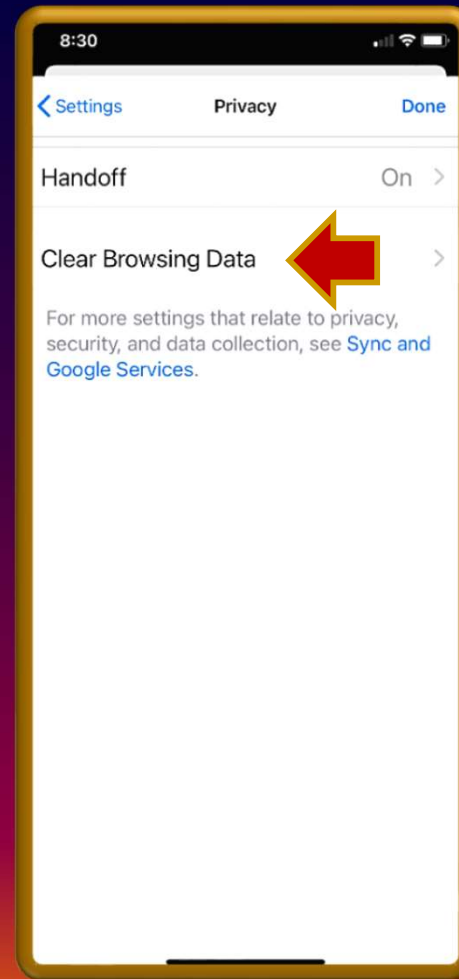
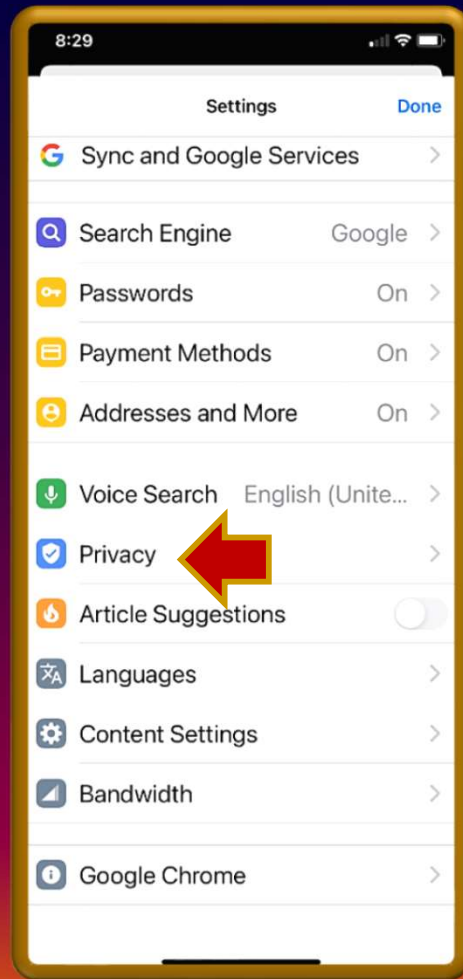
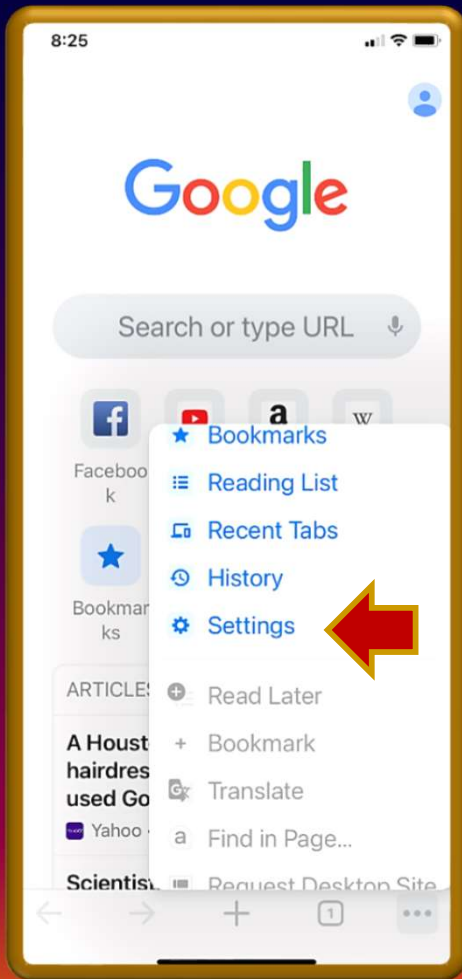
Browsers will normally clear cookies that reach a certain age, but clearing them manually may solve problems with web sites or your browser.

90% of issues reported by users AND Administrators are generally caused by Cookies & Temporary Internet Files. A first assumption should not be that "The Website is Broken!"

When & why should I delete them?
Cookies operate in the background, so they're not likely to cause much obvious trouble, but there *are* some instances where you'd want to delete them. The cached data in cookies can sometimes conflict with the website they refer to if the page has been updated, resulting in errors when you attempt to load the page again. Also, since cookies are actually files on your hard drive, they *do* end up taking up some space on your computer, and although each file is only a few KB in size, they can conceivably add up if left untouched for long enough.

There are currently 277 County Administrators listed in the system

County Administrators have access to all aspects of The Portal, but may only manipulate information about THEIR CCB within the CONTACTS & JOBS portions of The Portal – though they are able to view other CCBs information. The FILES and BEST PRACTICES sections of The Portal are shared administratively across the state.

All CCBs have at least one County Administrator. CCBs should evaluate the need of each employee for access to MCP & The Portal. Working in either of these areas without training/experience can be problematic if an error should accidentally be made. County Administrators have broad authority to create, manage and customize nearly all aspects of their CCB's portions of MyCountyParks.com and The Portal. They **CANNOT DELETE Parks or Facilities** once they are saved to the system (Email request required to be sent to SYSADMIN for removal)

RANGER (UPGRADED 2021)

High Level of Security for MCP.com – NO ACCESS to The Portal, and no Admin capability for any other profiles. Ranger Profile can be assigned to multiple OR ALL parks in the county by the County Administrator or SYSADMIN.

- CAN ADD/EDIT FACILITIES

This broad-ranging upgrade to this Profile is significant, and County Admins should carefully consider how many employees should be assigned to multiple parks.

REGISTERED USER

Public Profile – No Security Concerns
Each Registered User Profile is unique by virtue of an email address that is not found elsewhere in the system. They may/may not be visible to you depending on preferences checked on their Profiles or if they are a previous customer.

There are currently **130,705** Registered Users listed in the system

More than 65% of Registered Users have never made a purchase through the website – but have provided their personal information to receive additional information about particular interests or from selected counties. The database is massive and totals 1,305+ pages of data.

During the busiest spring & summer seasons, there are days when we have received 250-300 new Registered Users per day.

The best method for you too harvest their CONTACT DATA is via the Users or Customer tabs in your county's administrative navigation.

PUBLIC SIDE USER - This is the profile that either the user of the website can create for themselves, or you can assist them by creating one for them administratively. Currently, in order to purchase anything (facility reservation or event registration) the user **MUST** have created a PROFILE on the website in order to complete any purchase

PORTAL VIEW ADMINISTRATOR

Medium Level of Security for Portal Only – viewing access only to all information in the CONTACTS, FILES and JOBS tabs. Can view, comment, save and delete their own responses in the BEST PRACTICES. Can be created by County Administrator & SYSADMIN

There are currently 5 Portal View Admins listed in the system

Portal View Administrators (New in 2021) have access to all FOUR TABS in The Portal, and no access to any portions of MyCountyParks.com. In CONTACTS, FILES and JOBS – the Profile can ONLY VIEW and export/download the data & information – no ability to upload or edit. In BEST PRACTICES, the Profile can view all the inquiries and upload a comment and/or attachments to an inquiry. The Profile can also delete their own comment, but no other editing. A Portal View Administrator Profile may be created by either a County Administrator or the SYSADMIN. (This new Profile was primarily designed for Conservation Board Members or specific staff that may benefit from access to information in the Portal)

PARK ADMINISTRATOR

Lower level of security – assigned to ONLY ONE park, and NO ACCESS to The Portal. Park Administrators have admin access ONLY the park they are assigned and can create & admin ONLY these level of profiles for the park they are assigned.

There are currently 21 Park Administrators listed in the system

Park Administrators can generally admin all features associated with the park they are assigned. They can add, edit and delete Events; edit or make Facility reservations for facilities in that park; view Reservations and print signs; add / edit Activities for the park / facilities; view / edit Orders; view / edit / delete Customers for that park, etc.

SYSTEM ADMINISTRATOR

Maximum Security Level – For all operations, cyber security and privileges related to MyCountyParks.com and The Portal, as well as MyCountyParks.org, all Social Media Platforms, and all interactions with website host & developer – Informatics; maintenance of all insurance, broader email system operations & support; licenses and certifications required for operations; PCI Compliance; tax filing and accounting; ICCS Division Liaison and financial accounting, etc. And Oh – there's that other ICCS CEO gig too ☺

There are currently 2 System Administrators listed in the system

Over the next couple of years, we will be migrating much of this administrative support to a shared effort between ICCS Staff and professional website developers.

SYSTEM ADMINISTRATOR - Since the "birth" of MCP.com in 2006, ICCS has made every effort to keep the support and management of the website "in-house". The exponential growth and demands that have come with the success of the site has brought us to the point where the site needs to have day-to-day operations of the website managed outside of the primary duties of the ICCS CEO. Look forward to our migration in that direction in the months to come – thanks! ☺

PORTAL ADMINISTRATOR

Highest Level of Security for Portal Only – access ONLY to The Portal, and NO ACCESS to the MCP website. Only the SYSADMIN can assign this Security Profile, and the Profile has no other admin rights for other Profiles

There are currently 0 Portal Administrators listed in the system

Portal Administrators can admin all features associated with The Portal – ALL FOUR functionality tabs. They can add, modify or delete any aspect, and any data contained in the Portal – this is very broad and high level authority. (There currently does not exist a position within ICCS or any CCB that would warrant this total access to all that is in the Portal)

PORTAL USER

Lower Level of Security for Portal Only – access to ONLY the FILES tab and the JOBS tab in The Portal – no access to any part of MyCountyParks.com. Profile can only access and edit their OWN profile. Can only be created by the SYSADMIN.

There are currently 903 Portal Users listed in the system, mostly from pre-2014

Portal Users have Admin access only to the FILES TAB in The Portal. Clicking on the JOBS TAB will bring up the public view of the employment listings only – no Admin view or edit/delete opportunity. The Portal User Profile can view ALL items in the FILES and can upload and delete ONLY those files that their profile has uploaded. They can download, but not edit or delete any of the other files.

To create a Portal User Profile, a County Administrator can create a Registered User Profile for the CCB Employee or Board Member – then request conversion to a Portal User via an email request to the SYSADMIN.

1. REASON THAT "CONTENT" WAS CREATED – The ability for a **County Administrator** to create additional navigational tabs has been a feature of MyCountyParks.com since Version 1.0 was launched in 2009. Even though we are now operating in Version 8.1 (2020), there has not been much evolution of this feature. The primary function of these tabs is to allow a short-text title for a tab that will open up a simplified web page with limited functionality. They do not have the dynamic functionality of a PARK or FACILITY page and are therefore not meant (at this time) for several layers of "nested sub-tabs", that are called "children" in the administrative language of the site. The original vision for these tabs was to get the site visitor to click on the subject of interest, land on a new page with text and a photo about the subject matter – and then perhaps provide an off-site link to additional information, videos, pictures, etc. **IT IS NOT AN OPTION AT THIS TIME TO BROADEN THE SCOPE OF THESE PAGES.**

PDF vs. LINKS – REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE

A popular feature of our website is the ability to attach supplemental forms or documents to most any of the pages on the site. The success of the site, a 27% increase in use already this year, and the addition of the IACCB PORTAL in 2013 have all created a massive increase in the bandwidth consumption of the site. So much so, that we once again need to collectively be cognizant of uploading items to the site that can otherwise be linked to other websites you may manage, or to a free storage site. IACCB has no PDFs stored on the MyCountyParks.com, rather utilizes a free site (Weebly.com) as an online “warehouse” for Newsletters, the Preferred Vendor Program, Winterfest information, etc. Collectively, we can make a difference in the bandwidth consumption of MCP.com, and therefore help in keeping the monthly hosting fees at a moderate pricing level.

SUPPLEMENTAL: The IACCB current website **Hosting Agreement** carries a monthly fee of \$795.00 – which, in part provides for the annual calendar-year allowance of 2,100 GB of bandwidth consumption. (For reference, one GB = 1,024 MB, or about one billion bytes) Due to a 27% increase in website usage, we used up our 2,100 GB allowance by mid-September. You could call this being a “victim of our own successes”. Not unlike a data allowance on your cell phone, once you exceed that allowance – it can get very expensive. A busy band-width month at 303 GB like August would cost over \$3,700 in hosting fees utilizing the “overage” rates in our contract. IACCB is in a re-negotiating phase. I know, TMI – but wanted you all to know a bit of the background for the above request to get those PDFs assigned to alternative locations – many thanks for all that you do! 😊

My County Parks Banner Ads

This document is to help in the creation and placement of Banner Ads onmycountyparks.com.

First, a brief explanation of how banner display on the site: within the mycountyparks.com website there are zones where banner ads can display. Each county will have the ability to add banner ads and create campaigns that they can assign to a zone. Those campaigns can be weighted amongst themselves. Example: campaign 1: 20% and campaign 2: 80%. Within each campaign that is created you can associate banner ads to that campaign. These banner ads can also be weighted with the campaign. Example: banner ad 1: 30% and campaign 2: 70%.

The basic process for adding banner ads to the website is:

- 1) Create banner ads
- 2) Create campaign
- 3) Assign banner ad to campaign
- 4) Assign campaign to zone
- 5) Maintain Weights

Below are the requirements for each type of banner.

Banner Ad: Images

Images that are uploaded must fit the following requirements:

1. Must be a JPEG or GIF
2. Must be 72 dpi and optimized for the web
3. File size not to exceed 80K
4. Image Dimensions: Default size of 468px by 60px
5. Images can not be Flash, BMP, PNG

Banner Ad: Scripts

Scripts for the website must fit the following requirements:

1. A script tag is a way for your sponsor to collect statistic information on their banner ad.
2. Script tags may be provided by your sponsor if they choose.
3. In most situations when a script is used all stats for that banner will be tracked outside of the My County Parks system.
4. Our system displays the script as is. Any special modifications are up to the administrative user to complete.
